

Livingston County Women's Chorus General Information

- 1. When we meet** Mondays, 7:30-9:30 p.m. beginning January 8, 2018
- 2. Where we meet** Brighton High School Choir Room
- 3. Annual membership dues** \$120 per year/ \$65 per semester
- 4. Music Fees** Music is purchased by each singer and will cost approximately \$25 per semester. (Dues and music fees may be paid with one check made out to the Livingston County Chorale)
- 5. Attire** Black blouse and black skirt. The wardrobe chairperson will approve the uniform.
- 6. Attendance** Good attendance is required for success. Singers are allowed two absences per semester, after which the director may require singers to demonstrate knowledge of music before performing a concert.
- 7. Music preparation** Singers are expected to review and practice music at home between rehearsals. Practice recordings will be provided.
- 8. Performance schedule** Saturday, May 5 and Sunday, May 6; Performances may be added.
- 9. Extra opportunities** Solos, duets, etc. will be auditioned or appointed as the music requires. Ladies First auditions will be held as openings occur. Decibelles will audition new members as openings occur.
- 10. The Chorale Family** The WC is one of three choirs of the Livingston County Chorale Family (Chorale, WC, and Youth Choir). We are a non-profit organization led by a Board of Directors. Your dues help to defray a portion of the costs of the LCC (director and accompanist salaries, costs for venues, publicity, etc.) To help with the rest of the LCC expenses, all singers are encouraged to promote concerts, sell tickets and participate in fundraising activities.
