

Livingston County Women's Chorus General Information - Virtual Season 2021

1. **When we meet** Mondays, 7:00-8:00 pm, beginning February 1, 2020

2. **Where we meet** Zoom

3. **Annual membership dues** \$50 suggested donation

4. **Music Fees** Music is purchased by each singer and will cost approximately \$20 per semester. (Dues and music fees may be paid with one check made out to the Livingston County Chorale)
*No music fees for virtual season

5. **Attire** Black blouse and black skirt. The wardrobe chairperson will approve the uniform.
*No uniform for virtual season

6. **Attendance** Consistent attendance is required for success. Singers are allowed two absences per semester, after which the director may require singers to demonstrate knowledge of music before performing a concert.

7. **Music preparation** Singers are expected to review and practice music at home between rehearsals. Practice recordings will be provided.

8. **Performance schedule** *No performances for virtual season

9. **Extra opportunities** Solos, duets, etc. will be auditioned or appointed as the music requires. Ladies First auditions will be held as openings occur. Decibelles will audition new members as openings occur.
